

All Kershaw blades are manufactured of Kai Stainless Steel® from the AUS series (6A for pocketknives, 8A for survival and hunting knives). This steel is an improvement over famous 440-C, and has a hardness range of Rockwell C57-59. These high-carbon stainless steel blades are heat-treated by an advanced sub-zero quench to take an incredibly sharp edge that holds longer than conventional blades, and is also much easier to maintain.

Kershaw knives live up to the demands of their proud owners, whether designed for hard use out in the field or for performing the everyday tasks of a small pocket tool.

In addition, the expert Kai craftsmen take another step most other knife companies don't: Each part of a Kershaw knife—including the internal parts of all folding knives—is mirror polished to prevent rust or corrosion. And Kershaw folding knives feature that extra touch of quality, with perfect alignment between blades and handles—plus no-wobble blades that never touch metal during the folding action!

CRAFTSMANSHIP IN THE SAMURAI TRADITION.

Incorporating the most advanced metallurgy techniques and meticulous handcraftsmanship, each Kershaw survival knife is not only a collectors'-quality masterpiece, it's a functional, durable survival tool—a tool that performs in even the most severe conditions.

The AUS-8A double-edged blades are taper ground to a shaving sharp edge while the handles are specially balanced to fit the hand comfortably during use. In addition, a custom-formed leather sheath comes with each Kershaw survival knife. Featuring a metal spring clip with a safety bar on the back, this sheath can be worn on a belt or clipped to the top of a boot. The Amphibian is also available with an ABS divers' sheath with velcro straps for underwater use. The straps can be removed and the sheath worn on the belt if desired.

TrooperThe Trooper's blade is virtually inseparable from its fine grain ebony handle because the tang extends throughout the entire length of the handle. (The buttcap is locked into place by a stainless steel pin that actually pierces the threaded tang.) Each Trooper is an indi-vidual handcrafted work of art and is marked with its own serial number. It is shipped complete with a superb hard-side presentation case, a registration card, and a metal plate (which can be engraved and mounted on the outer cover of the case.)

Special Agent
The Special Agent is a compact version of the
Trooper. An aluminum alloy handle is die cast
directly to the notched blade tang. For durability and non-slip practicality in wet or severe

survival conditions, a thermo-setting vinyl coating is baked onto the handle. A hole is drilled in the handle for a lanyard and the solid brass bolster/finger guard is a handsome safety feature.

Amphibian

A survival knife or divers' knife that does the job on land or in the sea. One solid piece of specially formulated carbon stainless steel with serrations on one edge provide the strength and durability for those really tough cutting chores.

As a safety factor the Amphibian features a rubberized vinyl grip and a flared guard at the bolster area to give the user complete confidence and complete control of the knife, even in wet conditions.
